

**ASPC Minutes:** 7/14/2007

**Meeting called to order:** 9:15pm by President Shawn Meyer

**Sec Report:** The minutes were read and accepted.

**Old Business:**

1. Chicago Trip: Tom Capiross said that the trip was planned for Tuesday the 17th. He, Ben, Henry, and Dave K. were going. Paul Waschak said that he was not off work that week.
2. Shawn Meyer brought up the proposed user fees that the congress wanted to impose on General Aviation. A discussion followed; Tim Weigle said that he would get the form letter that AOPA would send out and provide us copies to send. The fees would be charged to pilots of airplanes that used the Air Traffic Control (ATC) system, each time they made an initial contact. The Tax on aviation fuel would rise from 17 c a gallon to between 50 and 70 c a gallon.
3. Cassie Drummond said that she thought people were tracking better since last month's discussion.
4. Trustees audit report: Tim Weigle presented a report that as of right now we have a Balance of \$ 13,150.27 with equity of \$3,550.53. There was a deposit today of \$3,675.00. Tim stated that these figures were really an educated guess, and we would have to wait until the end of the year to get "good numbers". The end of lat year we showed approximately \$4,618.58. A discussion followed and Jimmy Drummond suggested having two sets of books; one that would have the jump accounts and the other to have club business. Chris said that we are not drinking as much beer as before and we are drinking more pop. He also said that the price of beer is down and pop is up, but fell short of advocating the consumption of more beer. The trustees concluded that the trend is in the positive direction and that the measures implemented last year are working.
5. Joannie said that members need to post their altitudes or the 12.5 rule will be enforced.

**New Business:**

1. WATER TRAINING: Paul Waschak will conduct water training August 13th at 6:00 PM. He will contact Geronimo to schedule time at Lake Tomahawk. Those interested should sign up, and Paul will post the sheet on the refrigerator. Time and date are subject to change.
2. Night Jumps will take place on July 28th. Training will take place prior to the jumps. Those interested should have their glow sticks and flashlights ready, and gear packed and checked no later than 8 PM that evening.
3. Kay Kuhns expressed concern about how long the DVD player was taking to make DVD's. There is a huge bottleneck after tandems are done because it takes 10 minutes to burn a DVD. She offered to buy the DVD player for \$50 if the club wanted to buy a new DVD burner. A discussion followed. A motion was made by Jimmy Drummond to sell the Player and purchase a new DVD burner for \$150. Seconded by Cassie Drummond. Motion passed.
4. Kay Kuhns mentioned that Brian Chagnot thought it would be a good idea to put web-cams in the clubhouse.
5. Kay Kuhns announced that jump rates were increasing because of fuel increases.
6. Kay Kuhns announced that the style and accuracy camp would be taking place July 22nd through 26th, if you want to fill loads we will be jumping all day every day during that week.
